

Magog Trust 25th Anniversary Singing Trees Appeal.



Singing Trees are tall standard trees with the crown, even of young trees, well above the top of the hedge. These offer perches for bird species such as yellowhammer and corn bunting.

Trees such as Hawthorn and Crab Apple are used as these provide fruit for birds in autumn and winter whilst the spring flowers provide nectar and pollen for insects. Small mammals such as voles and field mice quickly devour fallen fruit.
